Note that if you have already been on H-1B, that you do not have to go through the H-entrepreneurial way to obtain the Green Card without needing tons of money and without waiting years in the lottery system for the next H-1B. You can actually file at any time and start working when the H-1B is filed. H-1B's are issued normally for 3 years. However, the H-1B provisions have the ability to issue 1 year increments if you have an I-140 petition or the PERM pending for more than a year. In this way, the spouse of an H-1B holder can get an employment EAD on H-4.
