Sie verlaufen auf weiten Hängen und zwischen steilen Felswänden, führen über sanfte Almwiesen, durch arktische Gletscherlandschaften und auf viele berühmte Dreitausender. Alle Routen sind ausführlich und präzise beschrieben, Kurzinfos liefern alle wichtigen Angaben auf einen Blick. Kartenausschnitte mit eingetragenen Routenverläufen verschaffen einen guten Überblick über die Tour. Erstklassige Fotos machen Lust, gleich am nächsten Wochenende aufzubrechen - und mindestens zwei Tage im winterlichen Gebirge zu bleiben. Autor Michael Pröttel, Jahrgang 1965, ist Diplomgeograf und tätig als Journalist und Fotograf. Skitouren sind seine Leidenschaft.
