In addition to environmental maintenance and protection, the concept of sustainability enterprises recognizes the urgency required to enhance the quality of life via strategic practices that facilitate the socio-economic development and address a wide range of issues affecting the contemporary society (Asif, 2016). The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA) outlines the regulatory requirement on sustainability programs through the 2030 Vision along with the National Transformation Program (NTP) 2020 objectives. These goals show KSA commitment towards the attaining sustainable socioeconomic development that cuts across the contemporary civilization, in the midst of growing focus on sustainability initiatives (Alshuwaikhat & Mohammed, 2017). Nonetheless, the importance of sustainability initiatives has provoked renewed interest within the corporate management due to perceptions that these programs are linked to decreased operational costs and improved revenues. Modern research has supported these assumptions as successful sustainability strategies are believed to have a positive impact on the corporate value (Iwaro & Mwashu, 2013). In this regard, the paper seeks to analyze how organizations in KSA are advantaged by sustainability initiatives in the contemporary organizational management.

The Role of Occupation-specific Human Capital in Economic Analysis - Russell Alan Ormiston 2007

This three-chapter compilation examines the theoretical and empirical implications of occupation-specific human capital as it relates to current labor economics research. The first chapter demonstrates that acknowledging occupational specificity in the human capital model allows for a reconciliation of a long-standing theoretical dispute regarding the role of occupation in the labor market. The second chapter extends the literature by estimating the cross-occupation transferability of human capital using data on the knowledge, skills, and abilities utilized in each vocation. These estimates are then applied to verify displaced blue-collar manufacturing workers as structural "victims" given lower rates of human capital application in their new occupations compared to others displaced in the labor market. The third chapter investigates the relationship between high school employment and post-school economic outcomes, as it uses occupation-specific human capital principles to dismiss the notion that in-school employment provides the "marketable skills" necessary to stimulate post-school economic gains.

This book discusses the adoption of learning management systems (LMS) in higher education institutions. It presents influential predictors that may impact instructors' behavioral intention to adopt learning management systems in the context of Arab culture, as well as a unique model of technology acceptance that draws on and combines previous technology adoption models (i.e., a modified unified theory of acceptance and use of technology model - UTAUT2). By including new constructs, this becomes the first study of its kind exploring instructors' use of LMS in Higher Educational Institutions of Saudi Arabia and other countries of the Middle East. Nietzsche's "Ecce Homo" - Nicholas Martin 2020-12-16

Friedrich Nietzsche's intellectual autobiography *Ecce Homo* has always been a controversial book. Nietzsche prepared it for publication just before he became incurably insane in early 1889, but it was held back until after his death, and finally appeared only in 1908. For much of the first century of its reception, *Ecce Homo* met with a sceptical response and was viewed as merely a testament to its author's incipient madness. This was hardly surprising, since he is deliberately outrageous with the 'megalomaniacal' self-advertisement of his chapter titles, and brazenly claims 'I am not a man, I am dynamite' as he attempts to explode one preconception after another in the Western philosophical tradition. In recent decades there has been increased interest in the work, especially in the English-speaking world, but the present volume is the first collection of essays in any language devoted to the work. Most of the essays are selected from the proceedings of an international conference held in London to mark the centenary of the first publication of *Ecce Homo* in 2008. They are supplemented by a number of specially commissioned essays.
