Jahrhunderts und gehört somit zum Bunde der 'Tre Corone'. Was Dantes "Divina Commedia" für die Epik und Petrarcas "Canzoniere" für die Lyrik darstellen, das symbolisiert Boccaccios literarisches Schaffen für die Prosa: sein Stil war jahrhundertlang richtungsweisend für die Entwicklung der italienischen Literatur und Sprache auf diesem Gebiet und sein Name verlor bis zum heutigen Tage nichts von seinem Glanz. Insbesondere sein Hauptwerk, das "Decamerone", mit dem er die italienische Novelle zur autonomen Kunstform erhob, wird noch heute auch international vielfach zitiert und gilt als Wegbereiter der Kurzerzählung in allen westeuropäischen Literaturen, denen es zugleich ein unendliches Stoffreservoir wurde, was wiederum die Genialität des Künstlers unterstreicht.
